These cities can become IMLA members for only \$50.00 per year, as opposed to the normal \$375.00. IMLA provides significant services and training opportunities for municipal attorneys. If your city qualifies, just send in the extra \$50.00 with your TMAA dues as indicated on the invoice and TMAA will submit your City's membership application to IMLA.

Here are some other reasons to be a TMAA member:

- **Continuing Legal Education.** TMAA does CLE programs specifically for municipal practitioners. The Association generally does two (2) programs each year, one in Winter and one in Summer, providing about 6.5 hours of CLE credit, with 1.5 hours of ethics/dual credit. Registration fees for members are very reasonable, and the programs are consistently excellent.
- **E-mail Forum.** A computer e-mail forum sponsored by TMAA offers an opportunity to share information with and pose questions to municipal attorneys throughout Tennessee by sending a single e-mail message.
- **Municipal Policy and Legislation.** Membership provides the ability to affect municipal policy and legislation through affiliation with the TML and case law through *amicus* briefs filed by the Association.
